The above pictures of the GRID project were proposed last year. The GRID system is a 21st Century solution that would remove trucks from our freeways. GRID is the only environmentally superior alternative to conventional urban port and freeway growth in the works today, using entirely electric cargo transfer and transport modalities. The SuperDockTM, seen above, will drastically shrink required port footprints, thus opening land for development or restoration. A GRID freight pipeline would eliminate up to 70% of port truck traffic, freeing urban neighborhoods from pollution, noise, congestion, and stress, and diminishing or eliminating the perceived need for expensive and wasteful freeway projects.
