Dear Neighbor,

It has been a privilege and an honor to serve our San Rafael community this last year as President of the San Rafael Neighborhoods Association (SRNA). I am pleased to share that SRNA continues to advocate for key neighborhood issues with important community leaders and stakeholders across Pasadena. The San Rafael Neighborhoods Association's mission is to enhance and maintain the character and quality of all San Rafael neighborhoods through advocacy and an activated community. In 2025, SRNA engaged on several important local issues, including:

- Creating urgency to complete the Colorado Street Bridge Barrier project and remove the temporary chain link fencing that was installed in 2017 by meeting regularly with City engineers and attending meetings as the process moves along. The city is likely to make a final design decision soon.
- Monitoring trail improvement projects and fire abatement in the Arroyo being completed through partnership of One Arroyo Foundation and the City of Pasadena.
- Represented concerns of neighbors around the San Rafael Library regarding traffic and the proposal of a bus stop. Improvements were made to the intersection for safety, and the bus stop has been deprioritized by the City.
- Held SRNA movie night in San Rafael Park showing Shrek. The event was well attended and brought together families in the neighborhood.
- Coordinated a Salvation Army drop off day at the San Rafael Library. Community donations filled an entire truck.

As we go forward into 2026, SRNA will continue to advocate for important neighborhood issues including:

- Focus on the Colorado Street Bridge Barrier and influencing the City to execute.
- San Rafael Elementary School Soil Remediation project.
- Fire abatement projects in the Arroyo including goats being deployed to help.
- Another Movie night in the fall in San Rafael Park
- Community events such as Salvation Army drop off and Pancake Breakfast at the Fire Station.

I will return as SRNA President for 2026 and Cesar Quezada and Andy Gooden will continue as Treasurer and Secretary, respectively. We invite and encourage you to join SRNA.
